President's Report

2008 marked the beginning of the first year of formation of The Hong Kong Society for Diabetic Limb Care ("Society"). It has very much been a year of organization of council members and planning for the "Society".

2009 was the second year upon the formation of "Society", it has very much events carried out which complied with our Society's mission. My report for the tenure of the two years 2008-2010 are as follows:

Year 2008

- Formation of "Society" on 9th April 2008
- Core Group of Council established

A Core Group with members was convened by the President in April 2008 to brain-storm the ideas for the development of services to the public and to empower the skills of medical practitioners through seminars, workshops and etc .

- Participate the overseas conference

The Fifth Asia-Pacific Diabetic Limb Problems Conference on 11-12 October 2008 at Singapore. Ten scholarships offered for the member to apply. Three members were successful approved and granted.

Year 2009

- Convene of activity
 - i. The First Community Diabetic Limb Care Education Program jointly with Western District Council on 16th May 2009 at Sai Ying Pun Community Centre, Western District, Hong Kong. The number of participants attended is 200.
 - ii. Course - Lecture and Workshop for Recent Advances in Chronic Wound Treatment jointly with Tseung Kwan O Hospital, Kowloon on 17-18th October 2009 at Tseung Kwan O Hospital, Kowloon. Five oversea speakers were invited to present the lectures and work skills. The numbers of medical practitioners attended is 150. There had an approximately surplus of HK\$130,000 for convene the course.
- Press/Public media Release
 - The First Press Release held on April 2009 to foster and arouse the awareness the diabetic limb care for the public.
 - The Second Press Release held on October 2009 to deliver the message of the importance of the diabetic limb care to the medical practitioners and public.
- Participate the oversea conference

The Sixth Asia-Pacific Diabetic Limb Care Conference on 14th-16th August 2009 at Beijing, China. Ten scholarships offered to the member to apply. One member was successful approved and granted.

Year 2010

- Convene of activity
 - i. The Second Community Diabetic Limb Care Education Program jointly with Mongkok, Yaumati, Tsimshatsui District Board and Kwong Wah Hospital on 2nd January 2010 at Henry Leong Community Centre, Yaumati, Kowloon. The number of attendees was 200.
- Participate the community services
 - i. The Central and Western District Health Promotion Day 2010 on 10th January 2010 at Public Podium at Sheung Wan Market, Hong Kong. Booth and enquiry services set up to disseminate and arouse the awareness and importance of the diabetic limb care for the public.
 - ii. The Northern District Health Promotion Day 2010 on 27 February 2010 at Luen Wo Hui Community Centre, Fanling, New Territories.

Educational booth, enquiry services and limb care assessment to the attendees. The numbers of attendees was 250.


Membership status

- iii. To share and exchange the professional skills and experience on diabetic limb care management with oversea and Mainland medical practitioners;
- iv. To organize yearly conference to enrich the member’s skills and competence; and
- v. To do research, re-organize and re-format the evaluation forms for diabetic limb care management program.
